



Since 1983, Regional Hospice and Home Care has been providing caring end-of-life services to our community. We have successfully helped thousands of patients live out their remaining days in the comfort of their own home or nursing care facility with peace and dignity, while supporting their families emotionally and spiritually.

- After years of planning and advocating for change in state regulations, we built Connecticut's first and only state-of-the-art, private-suite, hospice center. We now are honored to care for patients in our home the *Center for Comfort Care and Healing*.
- In our first year of operations, we served **774 patients** in our *Center for Comfort Care and Healing* and in the community, while providing valuable support to their families.
- ▶ In 2015, our clinicians made **30,148 clinical care visits** to patients and their families.
- Our Healing Hearts Center for Grief and Loss provides more than **30** different programs, support groups, social groups, workshops and memorial events for children, adults, families, caregivers and community professionals throughout the year.
- ➤ The patients we have cared for have ranged from 8 days old to 104 years of age. We strive to support these patients and their families many of which include young children and make their time together as precious as possible.
- ▶ Healing Hearts Center for Grief and Loss participants have made **2,350 visits** for bereavement support since the Center opened.
- Approximately **13,000 visitors** have come to the Center to spend time with their loved ones and to participate in educational events on end-of-life care.
- ▶ We provide \$1.2 million in no-cost, community services which are supported by the generosity of our community partners.
